#### Start from School Project

Group of 10 volunteers in Sisineri, conducted the following programs in two government schools of Sisneri. HDSN would like to thank all the volunteers who have supported for the success of program.

#### **Oral Health Orientation Program at HDSN**

FirstAid training was organized by Milijuli Samaj Nepal with the technical support from Health and Development Society Nepal. Basic First Aid training was provided to the Mahila Samuha who are basically involved for welfare of the community.



#### **Aims and Objectives**

- The overall aim of the project is to provide trained manpower who will be serving community with a view to work together, for bringing about a change in the quality of life of these communities.
- Motivating people so that they can help the people in need.
- Producing the trained manpower that can help in the emergency conditions.



### **BABU** project-

Follow-up of the BABU project at Bhardeu continues.

Tooth brush and pastes were provided for three months. Similarly, hand washing antiseptic soaps has been provided for three month.



The nutrition and regular follow-up will be done by our paid FHCV members in both the schools.

During the Program, HDSN team has provided all necessary orientation to the teachers, students and health volunteers as well who will be conducting follow-up every week. Tooth brushing and hand washing programs were conducted in the school premises.



#### Oral health program at Dukuchhap

School Oral health program was conducted by HDSN team at Shree Ganesh secondary school at Dukuchhap, lalitpur.

Screening and treatment of all the students and teachers were done in the school premises along with oral health educations. Treatments were done in the form of restorations, extractions and fluoride applications.

Screening was done in Shemrock School by the HDSN team. Most of the cases were referred to the paediatrician because of the small age groups. The cases found were Nurshing bottle caries, tongue tie in two patients which have been treated later in the hospital.

According to the basis of need HDSN has

distributed solar lights in Sindhuli, Makawanpur, Sindhupalchowk, Rasuwa and Lalitpur.

The design of the solar light is effective and most of the people liked because of its efficiency and design.



Solar lights were distributed mostly to the geriatric people who don't have support from their offspring.

## **Prefabricated Health shelter**

With the support from We Help Nepal, HDSN has coordinated for the building of the prefabricated health Shelter. With the coordination of District Health Office Rasuwa, HDSN has built permanent pre-fabricated health shelter in District hospital of Rasuwa.



#### **Tratransitional Semi permanent shelter**

HDSN has built transitional semi permanent tunnel shelter in Simthali, Kavre upon the request of health post and community so that the health facilities can be transferred to the shelter from the damaged tent till the permanent health post will be built.



The two health shelters were supported by ANMF.



## Oral health program at Oracle Academy

HDSN team conducted oral health program at Oracle academy, Naikap. Screening and treatment of students and teachers were done in the school premises.
